

Bonus (5 points). Show that  $h=\frac{d}{c-5}$  is the solution of  $c=5+\frac{d}{h}$  by substituting in  $\frac{d}{c-5}$  for h in the equation. DO NOT just solve the equation for h!

$$C = 5 + \frac{d}{\frac{d}{c-5}}$$

$$= 5 + \frac{d}{1} \cdot \frac{c-5}{d}$$

$$= 5 + c - 5$$

$$c = c$$
